# Sandersville Elementary

# Arrival

Staggered arrival times:

- Bus riders at 7:05 am
- Car riders at 7:20 am
- Walkers at 7:30 am



Students will be reminded to keep their masks on as they enter the building. All students will use the front entrance so staff can utilize thermal temperature scanners for touchless screenings.

Students being dropped off by buses with monitors will have already had their temperatures taken but be monitored a second time using the thermal scanner.

If any student arrives at school with a fever or demonstrates COVID-19 symptoms, he or she will be escorted to the isolation room inside the nurse's station through the front office.

# Meals

#### Breakfast

Breakfasts will be grab-and-go in the front hallway meaning all items will be packaged together for quick retrieval. Students will eat breakfast in their classroom. There will be two serving lines, one for each hallway.



#### Lunch

A staggered lunch schedule will allow for the least number of students possible in the cafeteria. Students will sit in an assigned seat on a daily basis. Students will be spaced so that social distancing guidelines are followed. Students will come in through a single entry door. Cafeteria staff will help monitor distancing and floors will be marked with tape in six foot increments. Lunches will be single serve meals, with disposable containers and plastic ware. Self-service food stations and condiment stations will be removed. Keypads will not be used. Students will exit through a single door.



# Class Transitions



# **Special Areas**

- Students will move from the classroom to Special Areas.
- Special Area classes will have 10 minutes between each class to allow for cleaning.
- One class will transition back to their classroom before the next class exits to limit crossing in the hallway.
- Students will bring their own materials.

# Restrooms

- Classes will stagger times for restroom breaks.
- Classes will use assigned restrooms.
- Floor markings will be used allowing students to keep distance between each other.
- Students will use hand sanitizer when entering and then wash with soap and water when exiting.
- Custodians will provide restroom cleanings every 30-60 minutes.

# **Intervention/Supports**

- Students will move to intervention and support, as needed, based on service plans.
- Desk barriers will be utilized with all specialists.
- Areas will be disinfected and sanitized between each group.
- Students will bring their own materials, pencils, and paper.

# Large Gatherings/ Visitors

#### Assemblies

There will be no school-wide assemblies for the 20-21 school year.



# **Programs/Performances**

Programs and performances will be on hold for the 20-21 school year unless online opportunities exist.

#### **Visitor Access**

Non-essential visits such as eating lunch with students and volunteering will remain on hold for the 20-21 school year.

## Nurse



#### Nurse

- Students displaying symptoms will be sent to the nurse's stations for another temperature screening by the nurse or office staff.
- Any student with a fever (temperature higher than 100.4) will:
  - be placed in an isolated examine room for monitoring by the nurse or staff
  - o have their guardian called for immediate pickup.



## Classrooms



## Classrooms

- Classes will be disinfected by the teacher and/or custodians between transitions (specials, lunch, recess, etc.).
- Seating has been rearranged to maximize space between students.
- Desks will face the same direction.
- Common materials, manipulatives, and supplies will be avoided.
- Classrooms have been provided with extra products to assist with cleaning: sanitizer, approved spray, wipes, paper towels, etc.
- Door knobs, desk areas, chairs, and all other contact areas will be disinfected multiple times throughout the day.

#### Students

- Students are required to wear a mask.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided or students may bring personal sanitizer.
- Students will take home jackets and extra layers from the classrooms daily.
- Students will be asked to wash hands with soap and water multiple times throughout the day.
- Students will practice social distancing and follow safety guidelines set forth by the school and district.
- Students will be allowed to bring water bottles from home that will be kept with them all day. Water fountains will not be used.

## Dismissal



# **General Information**

• Dismissal times will remain staggered to reduce the number of students in the hallway.

# **Kindergarten Students**

- Kindergarten students will be dismissed to their areas first and escorted by kindergarten teachers and assistants.
- Masks will be worn and distance will be kept at all times.

#### **Bus Riders**

- Bus riders will be dismissed from their classroom.
- Staff will be assigned to each bus to help with loading.

#### Walkers

Walkers will be dismissed after bus riders.



#### **Car Riders**

 1st-5th car riders will be dismissed from the classroom and report the appropriate flag at the front awning. Kindergarten car riders will be dismissed at the backdoor.

#### Recess

### Recess



- Recess will be scheduled daily.
- Students will keep masks on during recess.
- Students will keep a distance of six feet while playing.
- Playground equipment will be off limits for students.

# After-school Activities

### Sharktime

Sharktime will remain suspended and may not resume until 4-6 weeks after FCPS returns to 5 day instructional weeks.



#### Extra-curricular Activities

All clubs and afterschool activities will be paused and only continue once FCPS provides guidance and/or approval, unless virtual options exist.
