News, Notes, and Reminders

MAP Testing- MAP Testing will begin the week of April 12th. Most students, both in-person and remote, will complete MAP Reading the first week. Students will complete math MAP Math the week of April 19th.

Field Day April 28- Sandersville is excited about our plans for Field Day. Mr. Baxter has been channeling his creative side to come up with games that allow distancing and require no shared equipment. We think our students will enjoy what is planned. We are not able to have volunteers this year meaning Sandersville staff members will run the events. We will have a virtual option for remote students.

Kindergarten Graduation and 5th Grade Promotion- FCPS has shared plans for graduations and promotions at all levels. Elementary schools are not allowed to have visitors for any type of spring activities. Kindergarten and 5th grade teachers are working on plans and will communicate with families regarding events on May 17th and 18th.

KPREP Testing- 3rd-5th Graders will take a shortened version of our state accountability test, KPEP, this year. The window opens April 29th with students likely testing the weeks of May 3rd and May 10th. More information will be communicated no later than the week of April 26th.

PTA News: SBDM Parent Nominations- One of the many ways our PTA supports the school is through running the School Based Decision Making (SBDM) Parent Election. The SBDM is a decision making group for Sandersville that is responsible for tasks such as reviewing or creating policies, approving decisions around budget and staffing, and writing and monitoring the annual School Improvement Plan which is required for all schools.
